

CIRCULAR NO. 11

SUBJECT.— Designations of proceedings before the Charity Commissioner.

The following proceedings shall be designated as 'Inquiries' and serially numbered as such: -

- (1) Inquiries wherein a special audit may be directed under section 33(4).
- (2) Inquiries under section 40 to determine the loss caused by the trustee or any other person to a public trust (attended by assessors).
- (3) Inquiries under section 51 on application for consent of the Charity Commissioner for filing suits under section 50.
- (4) Inquiries to determine whether a notice should issue to the trustee of a public trust for directions in regard to applying the funds of the trust cyprress (Section 55).

2. All appeals under section 70 shall be designated as "Appeals" and serially numbered as such.

3. Other inquiries or proceedings not covered by the above should be designated "Miscellaneous Proceedings" and serially numbered as such.

4. Registers of all the proceedings herein should be maintained in the office of the Charity Commissioner in the forms annexed hereto.
