

CIRCULAR NO. 112

Assistant Government Pleader,

SUBJECT :- *Suits or Proceedings in which the Charity Commissioner is party.*

It has come to the notice of the Charity Commissioner that suits or proceedings in which the Charity Commissioner is a party are withdrawn or compromised without his consent or approval, and the Government Pleader concerned informs the Charity Commissioner after final orders are passed by the Court, disposition of such suit or proceeding such withdrawal may be the result of a collusion or negligence on the part of the Plaintiff's relatives. There are cases wherein the Charity Commissioner would have insisted on the continuance of the suits by applying to the Court to transpose him as a Plaintiff.

In future whenever a suit or matter in which the Charity Commissioner is a party is applied to be withdrawn or to be compromised, the Government Pleader representing is requested to take time and to consult the Charity Commissioner as to whether he has any objection to the withdrawal or compromise and whether he would like to pursue the matter.
