

CIRCULAR No. 129

SUBJECT :- Increment of non-gazetted staff - Drawal of

(1) In partial modification of this office Circular No. 96, dated the 24th August, 1956, all the Regional Officers are hereby authorized to draw annual increments of their office staff working under them, under Rule 45 of the B.C.S. Rules, as a matter of course, unless it is expressly withheld.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in Para (1) above, all cases of increments falling under Rule 46 of the B.C.S. Rules, and cases in which broken period are to be counted for the purpose of determining the date of increments, proposals should invariably be submitted to the Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Bombay, as usual in the form viz., T.O. Form No. 9 -Periodical Increments Certificate supported by explanatory Memorandum, as prescribed under Rule 263 of the Bombay Treasury Rules, 1960.

The directions contained in this Circular should be acted upon with immediate effect.
