

## CIRCULAR NO. 131

**SUBJECT :-** Legislative Assembly and Council Questions - Priority to be given

It has been noticed that prompt attention is not being paid to Legislative Assembly and Council Questions and for supply of information relating thereto within time. It is quite essential that the information in respect of such questions must reach this office on the due dates in order to enable the Office of the Charity Commissioner to submit the same in time to Government.

2. It is also further noticed that the replies to such questions are given piecemeal and perfunctorily and without reference to any record in the office.

3. All the Regional Officers are, therefore, directed to see that wherever information is called for by the Charity Commissioner from their office in respect of such questions, the matter should be given top priority and see that the information is supplied fully and with reference to all record of their office to this office without fail before the date prescribed by this office.

4. These instructions should be carefully noted by the Regional Officers and the Superintendents who will be held responsible for any delay that might occur in future in such cases.
