

CIRCULAR NO. 139

SUBJECT:- Instruction to be followed by the Regional Offices in respect of inquiries of Inspection.

During the inspection of the Public Trusts Registration Offices, it is observed by the Charity Commissioner that the Regional Officers entrust some of the judicial inquiries to their Inspectors for local inquiries and reports. While entrusting the judicial inquiries, the Regional Officers hand over the entire record of the case to the Inspector along with the Roznama of the cases with the result the Regional Officers do not exercise any control over the further proceedings of that case till a report is received from the Inspector which sometimes takes a very long time.

In order to check the timely submission of the report by the Inspector to whom judicial inquiries are entrusted, the Charity Commissioner is pleased to instruct that while entrusting such case to the Inspectors, the Regional Officers should not hand over the Roznama of the case to the Inspectors and in the Roznama it should be mentioned that the matter is entrusted to the Inspector for local inquiry and report. The case should be taken on board on fixed date for receipt of report of the Inspector and this should be mentioned in the Roznama till the report is received from the Inspector who should be remained to expedite the report if the same is not received in time.

All the Regional Officers are instructed to see that these instructions are followed in respect of all present and further inquiries entrusted to the Inspectors.
