

***CIRCULAR No. 149***

***SUBJECT-*** *Maintenance of register for prosecutions cases.*

During the inspection by the Government of a Regional Office it was found that the prosecutions were not filed against the trustees concerned for four years after the orders of the Charity Commissioner according sanction to such prosecutions were received in the Office. The Regional Officers are now instructed to maintain a Register in the accompanying form regarding prosecutions to be filed under various sections of the Bombay Public Trust Act.

2. It is also noticed that the Pleaders or Advocates to whom the cases are sent for drafting the complaints and filing them in the Court take long time to do so. In order to avoid the delay on their part it would be better if the draft of the complaints is prepared in the office of the Regional Officers and the same is sent to the Pleader or Advocates concerned who should be asked to go through the draft himself and prepare final complaint.

3. The prosecution register should be maintained up-to-date and should be reviewed by the Superintendent and put for perusal before the Regional Officer in the first week of every month. The Regional Officer should scrutinise this register in order to ascertain that no prosecution case is lying unattended in his office.
