

CIRCULAR No. 152

SUBJECT- Minister and Member of the Legislative Assembly and Council by the number of the Staff.

It has been brought to the notice of the Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Bombay, that certain members of the staff in the Charity Commissioner's Organisation have approached certain ministers and members of the Legislative Assembly and Council to redress their grievances. This was done by them without obtaining the previous permission of the Charity Commissioner or the Secretary, Law and Judiciary Department.

This act of the members of the staff in approaching the Ministers and Members of Assembly and council for redressing their grievance without prior permission is against Government Orders and contrary to Rule 16 of the Rules for the Preparation, Submission and Disposal of Applications to Government.

The Charity Commissioner has seriously viewed this type of lapses on the part of certain members ignoring the existing Rules framed by Government in this behalf.

All Members of the staff in the Charity Commissioner's Organisation are hereby instructed to follow the instructions contained in Rule 16 referred to above scrupulously for approaching the members of the Assembly and councilor Ministers etc., to redress their grievances. Any violation or the breach of the instructions contained in this Rule will be seriously dealt with.
