

**CIRCULAR No. 153**

***SUBJECT- Disposal of Judicial Cases.***

In the monthly meeting held in the chamber of the Secretary, Law and Judiciary on 6th March 1972 it was observed that the disposal of Judicial cases was less than the receipts in the month of January 1972 in cases of some Regions. The explanation of these Regional Officers is being called. The Regional Officers will see in future that as far as possible the disposal are more than receipts. Similarly, they will attend to the old pending cases with them.

In some Regions the old cases have remained untouched because they are bulky. The Charity Commissioner desires that there should be no old cases pending in any Region by the end of April 1972, or at any rate by the end of May 1972.

2. In future if the disposals are less than the receipts, the Regional Officer concerned will give explanation for the less disposals by attaching the note to the monthly statement. This is necessary to explain to the government less disposal. The explanation for less disposal than receipts for the month of January and February should be submitted by the Regional Officers, in whose officers the disposal is less.
