

CIRCULAR No. 155

SUBJECT- Attendance of inspectors in the Public Trusts Sub-Regional Offices at their Head Quarters.

The Public Trusts Sub-Regional Offices in the District places are opened for the benefit of the public and trustees who visit these offices for guidance, inquiry and advise.

2. It is observed that when the visitors visit these offices, they do not meet the Inspectors who are reported to be out of Head Quarters on tours, with the result that a great inconvenience is caused to these visitors. It is necessary to fix particular dates in a month on which dates the Inspectors shall invariably remain at their Head Quarters except for the exceptional and emergent reasons and these dates when the Inspectors is available at Head Quarters are made known to the visiting public.

3. The Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Bombay is therefore pleased to direct that all the Inspectors working in the Sub-Regional offices shall necessarily remain at their Head Quarters on 5th to 7th, 16th to 18th and 25th to 27th dates of each month for the convenience of the visiting public and they shall notify these dates as their halt at Head Quarters on their office notice board and also on the notice board of Regional Office for the information of the visitors.

4. The Regional Officers will see that these instructions are complied with scrupulously and will give publicity to these instructions for the information of the Public.

5. The Inspectors should send a compliance report in this behalf to the Charity Commissioner through their Regional Officers.
