

***CIRCULAR No. 157***

***SUBJECT- Removal of Trustees on Conviction.***

As the amendments to the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 are coming into force shortly and as the powers to appoint trustees and remove the trustees for any of the reasons specified in sub-section(1) of section 47(amended) will be vested in the charity commissioner and as one of the reasons for removal is conviction of the trustees under the provisions of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 or for an offence involving moral turpitude, it is necessary that the Charity Commissioner should have the information in respect of conviction of trustee of any trust for the aforesaid offence.

All the Regional Officers are therefore requested to send certified copies of the Orders of the Court in the criminal complaints in which the trustees are fined or sentenced to punishment immediately on disposal of such complaints. The Regional Officers should also furnish the information with regard to age, occupation and full address of the trustee or trustees convicted and proposed to be removed.
