

CIRCULAR NO. 166

SUBJECT :- Instruction to the Inspectors about if the trustee insolvent.

Now Sub-Regional Officers are established at every District places, The instances have come to the notice of the Government and the Charity Commissioner that even if the sole trustee of a Trust dies that information does not reach the Charity Commissioner or Deputy or Assistant Charity Commissioner's Office for many years, with the result that the management of the Trust is assumed by some unauthorised persons Inspectors in charge of the Sub-Regional Offices should therefore make it a point to pay brief visits to all the trusts in their Districts ordinarily once in a year and especially these having one trustees only and see whether the Trust is run by proper trustees, that the meeting of the Board of Trustees are held punctually and that the accounts also are maintained punctually. During such visit he should also ascertain whether the income shown by the trustees of small trusts is correctly shown or is purposely shown less.
