

CIRCULAR NO. 184

SUBJECT :- Directly approached to M.L.A. or the leaders of the political parties with their grievances connected with the official matter..

In spite of instructions issued in Circular No.152 dated 17th January 1972, it has been brought to the notice of this Office that some members of the staff in Charity Organisation have directly approached M.L.As or the leaders of the Political parties with their grievances connected with the official matters such as transfer, promotions or claims to seniority

All the members of the staff in Charity Organisation should note that approaching M.L.As. or any outsiders for redress of grievances is clearly a breach of Rule No.23 of the Bombay Civil Services (Conduct and Discipline and Appeal) Rules. A Government Servant who commits breach of this Rule would be liable for disciplinary action unless the Government Servant concerned can prove that such approach has been made without his knowledge.
