

CIRCULAR NO. 197

SUBJECT :- Delay at Superintendent's Level

From reports submitted it is noticed that cases of Government references sent to regions remain unattended for months together at the table of the Superintendents. In one case the matter was not sent to the Inspector for Inquiry for a year or more. As a result of such delay the references from Government remain pending for a long time and parties go on sending reminders to authorities at all levels.

With a view to avoid all such delay and unnecessary correspondence by way for reminders, the Charity Commissioner directs that the Regional Officers should inspect the table of Superintendents periodically and see that no correspondence or cases especially Government references are delayed.

Officers and Superintendents may note that by such delay the image of the department in the public as well in Government is distorted.
