

CIRCULAR No. 240

SUBJECT- Instruction to dispose of Judicial cases expeditiously

Complaints have been received from the public that in judicial matters they are called several times obviously without sufficiently justifiable reasons and that in general there is considerable delay in disposal of judicial and quasi judicial inquiries

It is moreover observed from perusal at random of a few cases of the Public Trust Registration Office, Greater Bombay Region, that roznamas are not being written correctly and in time and that adjournments are being granted on flimsy grounds or without recording any reasons. It is also observed that considerable time is taken for fixing cases for the first time.

It is an oft repeated fact that most of the Trustee/office bearers are social workers devoting their time in an honorary capacity. It is, therefore, the duty of the Regional Officers to dispose of the cases as expeditiously as possible.

All the Regional Officers are therefore again hereby directed to see that in all judicial cases, roznamas are written correctly and in time and that fresh cases are taken up with the least possible delay.
