

CIRCULAR NO. 33

SUBJECT.— The Register of Public Trusts - Information to be entered in the “Remarks” column and verification of entries in—

The form of Register of Public Trusts prescribed under the Bombay Public Trusts Rules, 1951, does not provide separate columns for making entries about (i) the date of registration of a public trust and (ii) the name and address of the trustee or manager to whom any communication in connection with the trust may be sent.

The above information will, however, be of great importance to the public and should invariably be entered in the Register of Public Trusts in the “Remarks” column.

The Register of Public Trusts is of vital importance and it is essential that there should be no errors in it whatever. Some responsible person other than the person who has made the entries in the Register should, therefore, verify them. The work of verification should be done by the Office Superintendent who should put his initials at the end of the entries in token of his having verified them.
