

CIRCULAR NO. 4

**SUBJECT.— Instructions in respect of Forms Nos. 1 to 4
vide Circular No. 3.**

1. For all these notices the mode of service shall be the mode prescribed in rule 9 of the Bombay Public Trusts Rules, 1951. No publication of these notices in any form is necessary.
2. Where a trust has a Managing Trustee, he alone may be served to the exclusion of other trustees. Where a trust has no Managing Trustee but a mere manager, or where there is neither a Managing Trustee nor a manager, all the trustees should be served.
3. Until further orders, service shall be by registered post, unless it can be effected in person by peon more conveniently and with less expense. At least 3 days' clear notice must be given to the parties, witnesses and assessors concerned.
