SUBJECT : Devasthan Committees – Appointment of a member of  
Archaeological bias on the .....

The Director of Archives and Secretary, State Board for Historical Records and Ancient Monuments informed the Government in Education, Department that at a meeting of the Regional Committee for Maharashtra of the State Board for Historical Records and Ancient Monuments held in Poona on 29<sup>th</sup> September,1952, it was resolved that the Devasthan Committees in the State of Bombay such as at Dehu, Alandi, etc. should have a person with archaeological bias associated with them. He requested the Government to move the Charity Commissioner to impress on the various Devasthan Committees the desirability of including in their committee a person interested in Archaeology.

The Government desires that the Charity Commissioner should impress on various Devasthan Committees the desirability of including in their committee a person interested in Archaeology. The Deputy and Assistant Charity Commissioner should accordingly get into touch with the various Devasthan Committees in their respective regions and do the needful. The names of various Devasthan Committees contacted by them may be communicated to the Charity Commissioner.
