

CIRCULAR NO.47

SUBJECT : Transfer of a public trust from the Register of Public Trusts maintained by one Public Trusts Registration Office to another.

When a public trust registered in one Public Trusts Registration Office is transferred, by the Charity Commissioner under Rule 36(iv) of the Bombay Public Trusts Rules,1951, to the Registrar of another Public Trusts Registration Office, the question arises what procedure should be followed by the two Public Trusts Registration Offices concerned.

On receipt of the order passed by the Charity Commissioner, the Public Trusts Registration Office, with which the trust is registered should forward all papers relating to the trust including the papers of inquiry for registration, together with a certified copy of the entries made in the Register of Public Trusts maintained by it, to the Public Trusts Registration Office to which the public trust is transferred. A note should be made in the remarks column accordingly.

On receipt of the abovementioned papers, the Public Trusts Registration Office to which the public trust is transferred should without holding any further inquiry for registration, make entries in the Register of Public trusts, maintained by it, in accordance with the entries shown in the certified copy of the entries referred to above, and issue a fresh certificate of registration under its own number under rule 8 of the Bombay Public Trusts Rules,1951, after calling for the certificate issued by the other office and canceling it. A note should be made in the remarks column accordingly.
