SUBJECT – Demand Notice –

Rounding up of contribution amounts while issuing .....

The Deputy Charity Commissioner, Ahmedabad, reports that trustees experience difficulty in remitting contribution by money orders as money orders for fraction of an anna are not accepted by the postal authorities. He has, therefore, suggested an amendment to the Bombay Public Trusts Rules authorizing the elimination of pies upto 5 pies and rounding up 6 pies and more to the nearest anna while assessing contribution.

2. The Regional Officer are informed that the question whether a specific provision in the Rules is necessary is separately under consideration. In the meantime, they should while assessing contribution, eliminate pies upto 5 pies and round up 6 pies and more to the nearest anna.
