Subject :- Disposal of inquiries by Regional Officer on tour.

It has been noticed that inquiries are very often adjourned by Regional

Officer while they are on tour, which results in waste of time and money. IN

order to have speedy disposal of inquiries the Regional Officer should as far

as possible sort out all inquiries pending in their Regions according to groups

either districtwise or talukawise, fix all cases of each such group

particular place, finish the hearing of all those cases and then proceed to hear

cases of the next group at another place. The Regional Officers should also

make a report on return from every tour as to how many inquiries were fixed

at a particular place, how many of them were disposed of and how many were

adjourned, Effect to this circular should be given immediately.
